Cavalleria Rusticana, an opera in one act, was written by Italian composer Pietro Mascagni. The first performance took place in Rome, Italy, in 1890 and was considered a great success. The presentation has been staged in major opera houses throughout the world and has become a part of the standard operatic repertoire.

The opera is usually presented in two parts separated by an orchestral interlude titled "Intermezzo." This transcription of "Intermezzo" was written specially for young performers.
